The company was very successful in commercial, industrial and manufacturing facility construction throughout the region. Hubert married

Rhonda Atkins in 1984. After Wendell retired from Davis & Hawkins in 1987, Hubert and Rhonda ran the company until his retirement in 2005. He was a strong shoulder for his family, friends and employees throughout his career. He enjoyed hunting and fishing when he was more active. More recently, one of his favorite pastimes was going to Bossier City with Rhonda and his cousin, Eloise, and her husband, Mike. Hubert was preceded in death by his parents, Amos and Hallie Hawkins; his daughter, Cynthia Lee Hawkins Cheatham; grandson and son by adoption, Robert M. Hawkins and his wife, Mickey L. Hawkins, and her son, Douglas Sandefur. Survivors: His wife of 26 years, Rhonda; son, Ralph Hawkins and wife, Susan; granddaughter and daughter by adoption, Kimberly Phillips; his children by marriage, Chris and his wife, Jill, and Shawna Atkins.
