HURST -- Annie Laura Fein, 88, passed away Friday, Nov. 11, 2011, at a local care facility. Funeral: 10 a.m. Tuesday at First Baptist Church of Hurst, 1801 Norwood Drive, with senior minister, Rev. Dr. Jeff Burnett, officiating. Interment: Following the funeral, Annie will be laid to rest in Laurel Land Memorial Park, Fort Worth, next to her husband of 52 years, Henry O. Annie Laura Stuart Fein was born Feb. 12, 1923, in Grand Saline, the second of six children to James Franklin Stuart Sr. and Mattie Elizabeth Stuart. She married Henry O. Fein Aug. 15, 1942. Annie was a longtime resident of Hurst moving here in 1959. She worked for R.E. Cox and Company for 24 years before retiring in 1979. She received The Pioneer Award from the city of Hurst and lifetime membership of H-E-B Methodist Hospital Auxiliary. Her other memberships included First Baptist Church of Hurst from 1959 until her death, Oak Crest Woman's Club, Auxiliary H-E-B Hospital, Hurst Chapter of AARP and Senior Citizens Advisory Committee for the city of Hurst.
