FORT WORTH -- Archibald Eugene Crow, 92, passed away peacefully Sunday morning, Aug. 9, 2009. Service: A memorial Eucharist will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. John's Episcopal Church, 2401 College Ave. His family will greet friends following the service. A native of Albany, Archie was born Feb. 16, 1917, the son of Eugene and Pearl Booth Crow. He graduated from Albany High School before attending Baylor University and Texas Tech. He was a longtime member of St. John's Episcopal Church, where he served on the vestry and in other positions.
