As a result of her husband's corporate transfer, the family relocated to North Texas in 1981, residing in Eules. She was a member of Martin United Methodist Church. Betty also loved doing volunteer work with the Neuro Fitness Foundation in Eules and she enjoyed sewing and quilting. Her parents preceded her in
