Texas in 1966. Clarence worked for a couple of Fort Worth area banks until starting

his own Building, Development and Real Estate Company. Along with a few

other

community members, Clarence was instrumental in breaking ground for the Keller

Youth Association Sports Complex. The current complex began with a meeting room/concession

stand and 3 baseball fields, all of which are still in use today. Clarence was pleased to

know that hundreds of children have enjoyed the use of these sports fields that are a part

of the current Keller Youth Association complex that consists of several baseball and

football fields.
