June 21, 1961 - April 19, 2010

Clay Valan Bolin, 48, formerly of Fritch, passed away on April 19, 2010 in Wagoner, OK. He was born on June 21, 1961 in Borger. He graduated from Sanford-Fritch High School in 1979. He then graduated from Frank Phillips College in Borger, where he was a member of the Rodeo Team. In 1997 he earned his Bachelor's degree in Environmental Resources from Southwest Texas State University in San Marcos. He was a supervisor in Oil Field Construction, and worked the last 10 years for Jomax Pipeline Construction.

He is survived by his mother, Myra Hammond of Aubrey; long time companion, Maryan Davies of Austin; one brother, Carey Bolin of Sanford; and one sister, Casey Southard and husband Alan of Pilot Point. He is also survived by one nephew, Wesley Southard and one niece, Paige Southard both of Pilot Point; as well as a host of loving aunts, uncles, and cousins .
