FORT WORTH -- Darmond Wayne Matlock, 89, a retired technical assistant in metallurgist engineering, died Wednesday, Aug. 23, 2006, at an area hospital. ♂ Graveside service: 11 a.m. Saturday in Greenwood Cemetery. ♂ Darmond was a veteran of World War II and obtained the rank of sergeant in the U.S. Air Force.
