As a Rice Owl, Don was a member of the basketball team, which he represented as an All American in 1954. He was selected as All Conference player in the Southwest Conference in 1953 and 1954. He was named to the Rice University Basketball Hall of Fame and had his jersey retired on Jan. 2, 2004. It is mounted in the Autry Court in Rice University Basketball Stadium. Don entered the insurance business in 1957, the same year he married his wife, Tanya. His professional executive insurance career encompassed more than 40 years.
