FORT WORTH -- Eunice Saltzberg Caughey died peacefully Sunday morning, Feb. 14, 2010, in her 98th year at a Dallas retirement center. Service: 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Kornbleet Memorial Cemetery Chapel, 411 N. University Drive. Rabbi Alberto "Baruch" Zeilicovich will officiate. Following committal prayers, Eunice will be laid to rest next to her husband, David, in Ahavath Sholom Cemetery.
