



## Gwanetha Ruth Roberts

January 19, 1936 - February 2, 2017

After a short illness, Gwanetha Ruth Bartelson Roberts was called to be with our Lord, on Thursday, February 2, 2017. Gwanetha was born in Audubon, Iowa on December 16, 1936. She was the second child of five, born to Ruth Jensen Bartelson and Forest O. Bartelson. She grew up and attended school in Hastings, Nebraska.

She married Hal D. Roberts in September 1962, and for the next 14 years, they traveled around the United States and Europe with his duty assignments in the U.S. Air Force. With his retirement, they settled in the Fort Worth, Texas area in 1976.
