May 8, 1915 - March 25, 2010

She received her bachelor's degree and teacher's certificate from North Texas Agricultural College, now the University of Texas at Arlington, and her master's degree from Texas Wesleyan College, now Texas Wesleyan University. She began teaching in 1936 and through the years taught at Harrison schools in Arlington, Hurst-Euless-Bedford ISD and in the Birdville ISD. She served as a principal for eight years and retired from teaching in 1977. She deeply loved teaching the Bible. A student of the Word, she taught Sunday school and children's church at 615 College Ave. Bible Church in Fort Worth, Mid-Cities Bible Church and faithfully attended Grace Bible Church with her husband, Lewis. She was a member of Phi Eta Sorority and the Retired Teachers Association of Albany. Hattie's family was very much loved and played an important role in her life. She was preceded in
