



## Jack McKannon

July 27, 1917 - March 25, 2010

Born in Denver, Colo., on July 27, 1917, Jack grew up in Omaha, Neb. In 1940, he moved to Glendale, Calif., where he worked as an optical technician. He served in the U.S. Army as a medic and optician with the 554th Optical Repair Detachment in Japan. Upon discharge from the service, he returned to California, where he met Margaret V. Blaine. After his wife, Margaret, passed away in 1984, he later met and married Nancy Lee Price in 1987, relocating to Fort Worth, where they lived until her passing in 2005.
