Jimmie Lee Robinson of Aubrey passed away at his home on June 25, 2008 at the age of 76. He was born in Amarillo, Texas on June 20, 1932 to Naomi and William Otto Robinson. He enlisted in the Army at the age of seventeen and retired at the rank of Staff Sergeant in 1971 after serving twenty-one years, which included both the Korean and Vietnam wars.
