He then joined the Navy and served his country in the Korean War from 1952-1955, honorably discharged as a lieutenant junior grade, then served in the Navy Reserve. He worked at Sikorsky Helicopter from 1955 to 1959. He then immigrated to Texas where he spent the next 34 years working for Bell Helicopter in engineering and marketing. After retiring in 1993, he spent many years consulting for Conklin and Dedecker, and Bell Helicopter. As a member of First Baptist Church Euless, he was an active deacon, taught third grade Sunday school for 16 1/2 years, was in the intercessory prayer ministry for 25 years, and faithfully worked as a volunteer once a month in the preschool area for about 25 years. Survivors: His wife of almost 43 years, Rhoda; son and wife, Lawrence and Eva Duhon; daughter and husband, Jessica and Kevin Long; grandchildren, Daniel and Jonathan Duhon, and Alex, Katharine, Ian, Joshua, Alaina and Hannah Long; brother and wife,
