FORT WORTH -- Jon Ian Berg died peacefully Wednesday morning, July 28, 2010, during his 72nd year, after a long, courageous battle with cancer.

Service: 1 p.m. Monday at Grace Lutheran Church, 7900 McCart Avenue. The Rev. Mark Moore, pastor of the church, will officiate. Jon's cremated remains will be placed privately in the columbarium in Dallas-Fort Worth National Cemetery.
