performed regularly with the San Francisco Opera, then moved to New York City where she

founder and president of the American Academy of Opera in N.Y.C. as well as being a loving

wife and mother. Lenore and her husband, Bob, moved to North Carolina where she was very

active in PEO and was the official soloist at the International Convention in Anaheim. She was

also North Carolina State president from 1987-1988. Lenore and Bob retired and moved to

San Diego, Calif., where both were very active with the Musical Merit Foundation of San Diego.

Lenore was preceded in death by her husband, Bob.
