DALLAS -- Louis Weltman, 86, died peacefully Sunday evening, Nov. 29, 2009.

Service: 3 p.m. Tuesday in Hebrew Rest Cemetery. Born April 10, 1923, in Fort Worth, Louis was the son of Sidney and Hortense Blumenthal Weltman. His maternal and paternal grandparents were pioneer Jewish settlers of Fort Worth in the 1870s and 1880s. His grandfather, Louis Weltmann, was a founding member of both Congregation Ahavath Sholom and Beth-El Congregation. Louis himself was a longtime member of Beth-El Congregation. He graduated in 1947 from the University of Texas at Austin and

worked as a chemist for most of his professional career. Louis had a brilliant mind and was known for his excellent sense of humor and his acerbic tongue.
