Wright, a beloved father, brother and husband, died at a Mansfield hospital shortly after midnight on Sunday, Aug. 1, 2010, after a prolonged and valiant fight with heart disease. Mr. Wright was born in Newby, Okla., on July 1, 1923. He served in the United States Army from 1941-1945 in the European theater of operations. Mr. Wright started a chemical manufacturing firm in 1948 and operated it with his brother until 1983 when he sold it to Georgia Pacific. Mr. Wright was a strong and determined entrepreneur who was loved and respected by all who knew him. He will be missed.
