Samye and Don would have been married 60 years in January. Samye was a wonderful wife and mother and enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren. She never stopped teaching and was a very talented artist. Samye was preceded in death by her oldest son, Bruce, who died in 1973. Samye had many friends and relatives.
