Sibyl Layfield passed away on 5 December 2011 at a Denton hospital. She was 92.

Sibyl was married for 51 years to John W. "Jack" Layfield, who preceded her in death.

She was a member of Fairview Baptist Church and later joined Justin United Methodist Church. She lived a life of service to others as a "Rosie the Riveter" during War World II, a teacher aide at Justin Elementary School, and a loving caregiver to countless individuals.
