He graduated from Mansfield High School in 1942 and joined the Army Air Corps in 1943, receiving his wings in 1944. He married the love of his life, Ellen Rose Cantrell, on Sept. 23, 1944, in Greenville, Miss. Warren retired from General Dynamics in 1988 after 38 years of service.
