Pilot Point - Willie Mack Webb, 91, of Pilot Point, TX, formerly of Memphis, TN, passed away on September 5, 2010 in Corinth, TX. She was born on November 5, 1918.

A native of Memphis, TN, she married Paul Webb, Sr. of Grand Junction, TN on November 24, 1943, in Memphis. They lived in Memphis, TN for 4 years and later moved to Kansas City, MO in 1947.
