Dean in 1988. They experienced six wonderful years of marriage prior to his death in 1994. Wilma had a love for gardening, particularly many beautiful varieties of irises, fishing on the Gulf Coast and entertaining family and friends at her home utilizing her Scandinavian recipes. In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in
